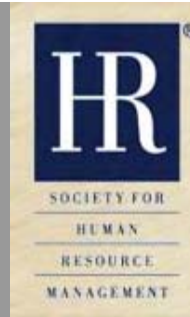

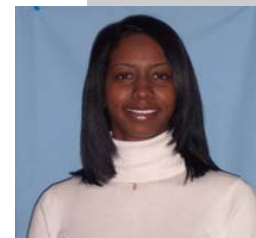
KIM HANSEN, HUMAN RESOURCE MANAGER MCCORMICK BARSTOW
